## Continuing Professional Development Requirements as per "National Standards"

Financial Counsellors who are Associate or Full SAFCA Members are required to complete 20 CPD Points of "Continuing Professional Development" each Membership year. This is 20 CPD Points regardless of the capacity of their employment.
